This week, begin to create Easter cards to send to friends, relatives, fellow church members and neighbors. Decorate your cards with Easter symbols (e.g. crosses, butterflies, lilies).

## RITUALS AND TRADITIONS:

Lent is a time to reflect on the life of Jesus and our own lives as his followers. Lent begins in the wilderness and journeys toward the cross and the tomb. In preparing for Holy Week and Easter, help your children experience the solemnity and importance of this season by together creating a "wilderness box." Place these symbols into a shoebox or cardboard carton:

- Sand: to create the wilderness (Mark 1:12-13)
- Twig Crosses: as a reminder that Jesus said that any who would follow him must "take their cross and follow me" (Mark 8:34-35)
- Stones: symbolizing the stone tablets of the 10 Commandments or the stones of the temple that Jesus said would be destroyed (John 2:19)
  Fabric "Road" or "Path": symbolizing the journey God's Old
- Testament people made through the desert, and our Lenten journey - Wheat: the symbol Jesus uses to talk about how dying brings new life
- Wheat: the symbol Jesus uses to talk about now dying brings new ii (John 12:24) Palma an Earry Free deviaded these an Palma Cunders
- Palm or Fern Fronds: add these on Palm Sunday
- Closed Tomb: add this on Good Friday (use play-dough or modeling clay for this)
- Flowers: open the "tomb" and insert these on Easter Sunday to symbolize the new life that comes to us because of Jesus' resurrection
