Trust

Proverbs 3:1-18

**Key Verses:** "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths." Proverbs 3:5-6

**Time:**  $10^{\text{th}} - 6^{\text{th}}$  century B.C.

**Background:** Today's reading lifts up the benefits of trusting God. On first reading, it may sound as though God is promising material wealth in exchange for trusting in God. But on further reflection, the reading speaks of something deeper.

The proverb proclaims, "Honor the Lord... with the first fruits (the first and best of all that you have earned)... then your barns will be filled with plenty." (3:9) God does not promise to change our pocketbooks. God promises to change *us*. When we give freely and generously, then our attitudes toward material goods change. "Plenty" is relative, and as God changes our hearts, we become satisfied with less. "Wisdom... is better than silver." (3:13-14)

**Community:** What are the things that the world entices people to possess? What evidence, if any, suggests that owning more leads to happiness? How might we change our attitudes toward material possessions so that those who have more might be satisfied with less? How can we change our attitudes into action so that there is a smaller discrepancy between rich and poor?

**At Home:** What makes you truly happy? What brings you angst? Add one positive thing and remove one negative thing from your life this week so that your life might be filled with the happiness offered by God.
