# God's Story Our Story

**Devotion:** Use this resource at home to guide your household's daily devotions. You can do this alone, as a couple, as a family; in the morning, during the day, or at night. Find a routine that works best for you.

**Pray:** Light a candle and open your devotion time with a prayer.

**God of understanding and insight, you have spoken words too great for us interpret, and yet when you speak, our hearts are warmed and our minds are stretched. Teach us your wisdom and show us how to live with joy and faith. Amen.**

**Reflect:** Reflect on the key verse from Sunday's reading.

*Trust in the Lord with all your heart,  
and do not rely on your own insight. Proverbs 3:5*

**Study:** Study the reading and consider the background.

**Proverbs, a book of instruction on right living, lifts up the virtue of wisdom. People who seek wisdom and righteousness receive happiness and contentment. People who live foolishly receive punishment and discontentment. A happy life comes from knowledge and fear of the Lord.**

**Read:** Read the following daily readings to deepen your understanding of Sunday's text.

After the reading, ask the follow-up questions.

Sunday, Proverbs 1:1-7; 3:1-8, *Trust and Honor God*

Monday, Proverbs 1:20-33, *The Call of Wisdom*

Tuesday, Proverbs 2:1-15, *The Value of Wisdom*

Wednesday, Proverbs 3:13-18, *The True Wealth*

Thursday, Proverbs 4:1-9, *Parental Advice*

Friday, Proverbs 4:10-27, *Admonition to Keep the Right Path*

Saturday, Proverbs 7:1-27, *The False Attractions of Adultery*

**What do these texts have in common? What are they trying to teach?**

**Connect:** Connect in conversation with others in your household. Discuss the following questions, or simply check in with “Highs” and “Lows.”

- **What was a high point of your day? What was a low point?**
- **What social norms are still consistent with the words of wisdom from the Proverbs? What social norms are contrary? How do you reconcile the differences?**
- **What are some of today’s words of wisdom that roll off your tongue? What do they mean?**

**Do:** By acting on what we learn, we make God’s word come alive. Do the following activity this week.

**Write down 5 sayings, quips, quotes, or advertising slogans that are common in your community. Write down what they mean and whether or not they are consistent with God’s words. Rewrite them so that they reflect the values you hold as a household.**

**Bless:** Close your devotion with a blessing.

**May God strengthen you with trust and honor. Amen.**

Announcements – Prior to worship, please hand a note to Pastor with any announcements, including prayer requests.

Prayer requests for the Bulletin – Please fill out a request card and drop it in the offering plate to insure your request gets to the office.

Bathrooms – They are located in the hallway to the left of the stairs.

Exit Strategy – Nervous to stand in line and talk to the pastor? Just introverted enough that you'd like to slip away? It's okay. Slip out the side door. No one will be offended, really. We hope you met someone today, but not at the risk of fleeing in fright from too much attention.
