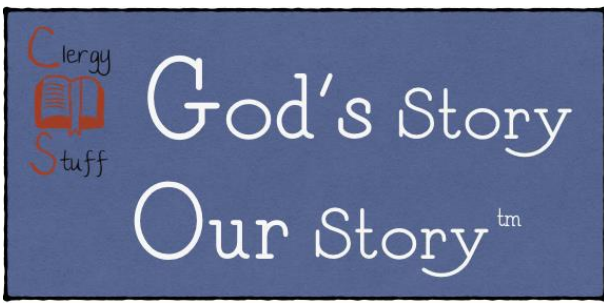

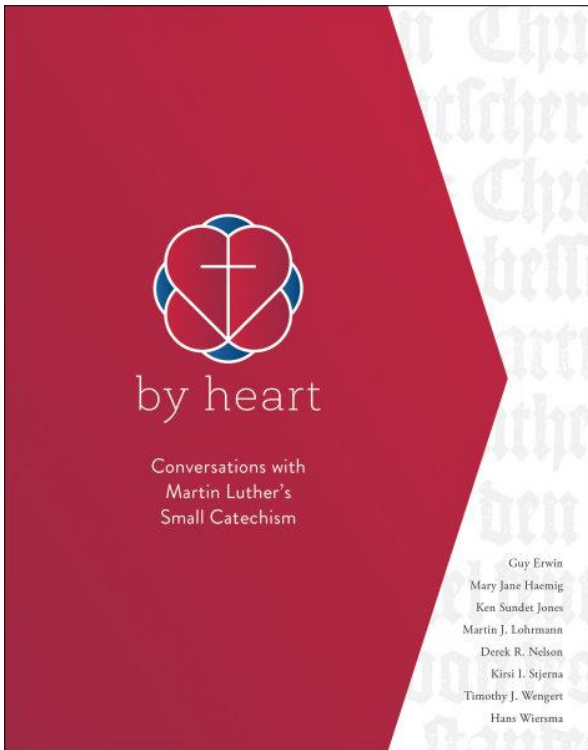
Food Shelf has an urgent need of additional volunteers
