### SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:

#### A Prayer for the Week:

We place our hope in you, O God, for we have known your unfailing love. Amen.

#### Mealtimes Prayer:

God, thank you for all that you've done to make sure we are fed. May we give ear to all you've said, and in your ways be led. Amen.

#### A Blessing to Give:

May God fill your life with faith and hope. May God renew you in spirit each day (2 Corinthians 4:16). Amen.

### CARING CONVERSATION:

Discuss in your household or small group:

- Name some things you appreciate about your brother, sister or mother.
- Jesus said that everyone who does God's will is his "brother and sister and mother." What type of brother or sister are you to Jesus?
- Finish this sentence: Having Jesus as my brother means . . .

### DEVOTIONS:

Jesus said, "If a family divides itself into groups who fight each other, that family will fall apart" (Mark 3:25; GNT). Discuss what draws you together and unites you as a family or household, and what pulls you apart and divides you. Pray for God's help to become a more united family. Pray that Jesus will be the "glue" that holds you together.

### SERVICE:

As Christians doing God's will, we are Jesus' "brother and sister and mother." We can show our love for our brother, Jesus, by serving the brothers, sisters, and mothers in our lives. Invite each family member to carry out one act of service for his or her brother, sister, or mother this week.

### RITUALS AND TRADITIONS:

Set aside some time this week to explore your family history. Make up a family tree showing your cousins, uncles, aunts, grandparents, great-grandparents and so on. View together any family history books you may have. Share what you know about the life stories of your relatives. Discuss ways in which your family history has shaped who you are today, individually and as a family.
