SAY, PRAY AND BLESS:

A Prayer for the Week:

O God, may we dwell in your presence, where love and faithfulness meet together (Psalm 85.10). Amen.

Mealtime Prayer:

Receive our thanks for night and day, for food and shelter, rest and play. Lord, be our guest and with us stay. Amen.

A Blessing to Give:

May you recognize that God has chosen you to receive great blessings through Jesus. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION:

Discuss in your household or small group:

- Share about a time when you were especially chosen for something. How did you respond?
- The apostle Paul tells us that even before the world was made it was decided you would be God's own child (Ephesians 1:4). How does this make you feel? Why?

DEVOTIONS:

Place a small bowl of water on your home altar or meal table. Each morning or evening this week, invite each family member to make the sign of the cross on another's forehead in remembrance of his or her baptism – the day he or she was sealed with the cross of Christ, given the Holy Spirit, and made part of God's "forever family." Join in saying the following prayer:

Dear God, thank you for loving us and choosing us to be part of your "forever family." Help us to shine with your love in all we say and do today. Amen.

SERVICE:

The Gospel reading for Sunday tells how John the Baptist was put in prison and later killed. Pray this week for people who are unjustly imprisoned. Visit Amnesty International's website (www.amnesty.org) to learn more about situations of injustice across the world. Find out how you can personally support the work of Amnesty International through letter writing or with a donation.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS:

Together, look through the birth announcements in your local newspaper. Birth announcements usually identify the parents of the child and give some details about the child's birth.

Ephesians 1:3-5,13-14 is our spiritual birth announcement. It says that we are God's adopted children, and that the Holy Spirit has been given to us as a sign of God's parentage. Together, write personalized "spiritual birth announcements" that declare your membership in God's family. Decorate these and put them up around your home.
