Pastor's Corner October 2012

Martin Luther once called the Bible, "The cradle that held the Christ child." And, this becomes fairly obvious when we are reading the New Testament. But, it becomes a little more difficult when we are talking about the Old Testament. Not one mentions specifically about Jesus, there are prophesies that will point to him, but nothing specific.

As we move through the Narrative Lectionary, one of the blessings is that it gives us the opportunity to focus more intentionally on the Old Testament. Once we start looking at it, Christ comes into clearer focus in the Old Testament. Scripture, all of it, shines a bright light on Jesus Christ. Scripture doesn't tell us what to do, as much as it lights the path for us and accompanies us along the way. We begin to see not only Christ's story in all of Scripture but our own stories woven into God's word.

It has been said that all of Scripture is God's love letter to us. It contains his undying promise to us. That love, that grace, is most clearly revealed to us in Jesus. So, in the Old Testament where Christ isn't specifically mentioned, when we see that love, those promises, we are led to Christ.

We see the grace, the love and the miracles we have in our everyday life leading us to Christ in a similar way. This is how God goes about creating faith in us, through the power of his Word. David Lose has said that the Bible begins in the beginning and ends at the end. This might not seem to profound until you realize that the end has not happened yet. We are living in the time frame that the Bible surrounds. This story is not simply an old history, but our story is part of it.

As we go forward into the Narrative Lectionary, may God's grace lead us to the Christ that Scripture and our lives point toward, the only source of the true life we all yearn for each day.




