

Pastor's Corner January

God's grace and peace to all of you as we begin a new year. Each year we seem to add resolutions that we all too quickly seem to break. I would like to propose one that I think will not only kept, but one that can truly transform and change us as a people of God. This resolution will not start immediately on January 1st, but we will begin to prepare for its start on February 13th.

Why February 13th of 2013? Because that date is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent. Lent from its very beginning was meant to be a journey. This journey was suppose to deepen the faith of those new and old to the faith. The early church entered into a time of deep reflection, questioning, and teaching. This was meant to deepen the life of discipleship of all believers. This has not been the case as of late. It has simply become, in many cases, the dreary lead up to our joyous Easter celebrations. Done correctly, it does not have to be dreary at all, and it will expanded the joyousness of the Easter message--knowing that it is one that echoes throughout our journey of discipleship.

So, if you are interested in growing as disciples of Christ during the season of Lent, beginning on February 13th, we have something for you. One of the best ways to learn is to ask and reflect on questions (answering is sometimes involved--but NOT always). Who could formulate better questions than Jesus? So in the 40 days we have of Lent, will spend it reflecting on six questions that Jesus asks of us in order to deepen our life of faith. Eric Burtness, a pastor in Oregon, has written a book called "Beyond Question." This book will serve as our guide for reflection. Then each Wednesday we will gather as a community to worship and study and discuss these questions in a way that will hopefully be a major step in your walk of faith. wow & WeeWow present souper bowl of caring


Our 3-6th graders have been working very hard on a video to raise awareness about hunger and its effects on kids.
