

Additional Business-

Update - Laurie shared a little about the Public Health requirements for serving food out of the Kitchen. She and Marlys went to a training meeting and will be putting together a small group to look into ways in which we can be in compliance with the new law and the guidelines without making it difficult for our kitchen volunteers. The goal is to balance effective food handling practices with our kitchen usage to reduce the possibility of illness.

- -Council updated their contact information; devotion and committee assignments were made.
- -Insurance update. Church Mutual did not submit a policy or fees. Costs for Grinnell Mutual (current provider) have gone down, so we will stay will Grinnell for 2013.
- -A motion was made by Dave A. to approve Brian, council president, to add his signature to the church checking account at Citizen's State Bank, seconded by Todd, motion carried.
- -3rd representative to the Synod Assembly: Sarah Hausken and Taylor Fennern were voted in by the congregation at our annual meeting as Representatives to the Synod Assembly in June. We can send up to three reps. Technically, we are to send at least one male and one female. Without a male representative, we would need to petition the Synod for approval to send 2 females. Broderick Prokosch is willing and able to attend the meeting in June. Eric asked if it is okay to send representatives under 18. Pastor assured the council that regarding age, representatives must be confirmed members of Cross of Calvary Lutheran Church. A motion to approve Broderick Prokosch as our third representative to the Synod Assembly was made by Marie, seconded by Dave A, motion carried.
- -Report: Equipping Congregations The topic of the seminar was centered around the equipping people for change and how the church can best respond. Pastor also shared he will attend a continuing education seminar on How to Welcome the Newcomer, keeping them engaged and involved in church life.
- -Report: Mid-Winter Convocation The theme was adapting to a changing world and included workshops on identifying the problem in order to be innovators. The staff received a variety of ideas to consider.
- -Communion procedures were shared
- -A Golf Tournament was discussed and a date will be considered.
