Pastor's Corner

During the our second midweek Lenten service I asked the congregation to come up with some of the qualities of their favorite teacher. This is what they came up with: taught by example, patience, pushed me, believed in me, caring, interesting, sense of humor, understanding, encouraging, and spiritual. The next question was how many items on this list could be applied to Jesus. Without exception, every single descriptor was one we all felt we could use to describe Jesus. And, I would have to agree that every single one of these descriptions is very accurate of Jesus—you can find biblical backing for each one!

However, in looking at the list there are some that, at least on initial glance, seem to jump out as contradicting each other. The most obvious in my eyes is "pushed me" and "caring." Now, pushing seems . . . well . . . pushy, and being pushy doesn't necessarily equate in our world with being caring. Because, let's face it, when we are pushed we aren't comfortable. And if we aren't comfortable, whoever or whatever is making us uncomfortable must not care. But, are they really opposites, "pushing" and "caring?" I would like to suggest that to push someone is to care about someone. When we care we want growth. Without growth there is decay and mold, After all, aren't we serve a living (growing) God. In order to get that growth we need to be pushed, even to the point of being uncomfortable. What is it that makes

muscles grow larger? Scar tissue. Scar tissue from muscles that have been pushed. If muscles

aren't pushed what happens? Atrophy? They

start to wither—no growth.

But just being pushed is not enough and is just plain nonproductive if it is not accompanied by the other traits—encouraging, understanding, sense of humor (because when we push ourselves we often times do silly things and look silly—laugh), patience, and believing in the person. As we push ourselves in our life of faith we don't do it alone we look to the person who has gone before us and goes with us—Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ cared and cares far too much for us not to push us. He is our teacher. We becomes not only his students, but his assistant and student teachers in one another's lives. As we teach we will be uncomfortable.

but we are never alone. It is out of this pushing,

and yes even receiving scars, that we grow and

strengthen our faith in the grace of our teacher

Jesus. May we follow his loving, caring, and

pushing example as we go into a future filled


