⁵This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him there is no darkness at all. ⁶If we say that we have fellowship with him while we are walking in darkness, we lie and do not do what is true; ⁷but if we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. ⁸If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ⁹If we confess our sins, he who is faithful and just will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. ¹⁰If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

If We Say We Have No Sin...

Key Verses: "If we say that we have fellowship with him while we are walking in darkness, we lie and do not do what is true; but if we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another." 1 John 1:6-7b

Background: Early believers disagreed on a number of things concerning

how to live as Christians. Often these disagreements led to behaviors that were destructive toward one another. Believers were encouraged to recognize their behaviors that were destructive, rather than life-giving, to own their sins, and to confess them. Confessing sins led to forgiveness, but withholding confession led to isolation and darkness.


Everyone fears the consequences of having their sins exposed. But hiding our sins doesn't prevent consequences. Instead it worsens the situation. God encourages us to be brave and face the consequences of our actions. God's forgiveness always comes with grace and mercy.

Community: How does your community hold each other accountable for their actions? What practices of justice are truly just? Which practices need to be changed? What might you do to work toward justice?

At Home: What sins are you hiding or hiding from? What would be the consequences of having your sin exposed? What are the consequences of keeping your sin hidden? What could you do this week to seek forgiveness of sin, and how might your acknowledgment transform you?
