Psalm 51:10

I read a devotional for our staff meeting last week and the theme was "a fresh start". It made me start thinking. I don't know about you, but I often need a fresh start. Especially after the first of the year, I make resolutions for fresh start on a diet or exercise. In our Bible Study we talk about making a fresh start with reading our Bibles and spending time with God. In our jobs we want a fresh start in a new position or a promotion. Some relationships need a fresh start to get past an ugly situation. There are so many ways we may need to start over. I don't know about you, but I don't always carry through with my intentions and then I am hard on myself for not being successful. But no matter out failures and



struggles, our shortcomings or inadequacies, turning to God in prayer is a good start. God has provided fresh starts for others in the Bible. Moses wandered with a searching heart and then was sent as a leader of a nation to save his people. David, a shepherd boy, is plucked from the field and chosen as the next king. Joseph is sold by his brothers and then became the king's advisor. Our stories won't be printed in the Bible, but they could be. God is actively working in our lives to make all things new. Our Lord was made the sacrifice of all sacrifices, suffering a horrible death on a cross because he loved us that much. But the grave didn't keep him. Jesus is not willing to compromise that love and makes us new every day. There is good news found in Romans 4:25, "Jesus was handed over to die for our sins, and he was raised from death to make us right with God." The good news of 2 Corinthians 5:17, "therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" Ezekiel 36:26 tells us, "I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh." And Romans 6:4 says, "We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too name live a new life." Go back and read each of these scriptures and put your name where I have underlined the Words. Pray these scriptures along with this one from Psalm 51:10, "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me." When should you do this? Pray continual (Thessalonians 5:17), and do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, present your requests to God with thanksgiving. (Philippians 4:6) And when we do not know what we ought to pray for, the Spirit intercedes for us. (Romans 8:26). Pray. Be made new.
