Cross of Calvary Youth News

<u>Cross of Calvary Ski day</u> for 7-12 graders and families will be Sunday, January 19. We will leave church at 12:30 and return at 10:30pm. (no school next day). Cost is \$21 lift ticket, \$19 rental, \$4 helmet. 7-12 grade are welcome to bring friends - Younger youth may attend with a parent. Families welcome. All must sign up (liability form) and pay by Thursday January 16th. To get the group rate, we must turn in one payment for our group. Liability forms and sign up will be on the board by the drinking fountain or if you request, I can send them by email. Again, you must pay by Thursday, January 16 to attend. Drivers are needed. OVERTIME for 7-12 grade, is an ecumenical community event sponsored by our local churches - with food and fun for kids AFTER a BOLD boys basketball game. Who: 7th-12th graders What: Pizza, Open Gym, Board Games, Crafts, Music, and Friends When: Friday, January 24th after the Boys Basketball game until 11:00pm Where: St. Mary's School How Much: The cost is \$2 per person for a full night of food and fun.

DODGEBALL LEAGUE for 9-12 grade: Our area churches are sponsoring a Dodgeball league for grades 9-12 on four Sundays: Jan. 12, Feb. 9, Mar. 8, and Apr. 5. On January 12th there will be food provided.
