We are thrilled to announce that thanks to a generous \$50,000 gift from the James and Mary Page family, we will be significantly upgrading livestream, sound and light capabilities in our sanctuary and fellowship hall!

During the past year of pandemic, Cross of Calvary has primarily offered pre-recorded worship on YouTube. That was well received, and we found many people worshipping with us who had not entered our church building in years or ever. We came to believe that online worship is something we should offer indefinitely.

Once we returned to in-person worship, we started livestreaming instead of doing pre-recorded worship. We learned quickly that our cameras, sound and lights were not up to the task. So, we started researching.

Our "Livestream Team" consisted of Adam Dillon, Tom Osthus, Steve Altmann, Kathy Reese, Leif Hausken, Gordy Blem and the Cross of Calvary staff. We researched options, received advice from neighboring congregations, asked thoughtful questions and checked references. We decided to recommend working with Excel AV Group out of Plymouth, MN. Excel AV Group has been working with congregation's non-stop for the past year to help them find solutions for sharing the love of Jesus Christ in this new era. We found them to be extremely knowledgeable and appreciated their willingness to assist us in making the most of this new system through training and accessible customer service. Our congregational council approved moving forward with this project because of the donation from the Page Family.

The project total is \$60,838. The Page Family is donating \$50,000 towards this ministry opportunity. We ask you to prayerfully consider donating to this project which will share the grace of God with our local community and far beyond.
