In Confirmation a couple weeks ago, I had the privilege of subbing as the small group leader for the 9th grade boys. Our assignment was to read from 3 passages, all from books of major prophets, Isaiah, Jeremiah and Ezekiel. This led us to a deep conversation and the question, "What is Hope? Like, is it, "I hope this happens?" On Sunday during Storytime, we were talking about the walk to Emmaus and 3 of the kids were very curious why I kept saying the word "die"? "Why did Jesus have to die?" Then in 4th grade Sunday school, I got the question, "who came first, people or dinosaurs"? Or "I need some science behind that." Or, the famous question, "Who made God?"

There are so many questions about God. It is why I love working with kids. They are honest and unafraid. They ask and wonder the same things we wonder as adults, but we don't ask.

Sometimes, because God is a mystery, there are no specific answers. Yes, those questions lead to some great conversations. But the bottom line, when we don't have the answers about God, about life; TRUST GOD. Proverbs 3:5-6 says "Trust in the Lord with all your heart. Lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will make your path straight." TRUST GOD. Isaiah 40:28 says, "Have you not known? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable." Whatever our questions, and there are no bad questions, we can be sure that God is almighty. Whatever we are wondering, God wonders with us. God suffers, celebrates, laughs, cries...with us. And never leaves us alone. When we don't know where to find

God, God is working through friends, family, neighbors, and strangers to guide, to strengthen, to encourage. Keep asking questions.

Prayer Garden project was started in 2007 to have a cement patio placed out from the kitchen door around the south side of the Fellowship Hall. There were two options given. #1- Cement patio outside kitchen door and around the side of the building, half way down the south side of the Fellowship Hall.
#2 – Continue cement all the way to the end of the south side of the Fellowship Hall. A suggestion was made to have grass planted along the south side of the Fellowship Hall for now.

After discussion with the council and cost, a motion was make by Kathy Reese and seconded by Bobbi Jo Abrahamson to only do option #1 at this time.

(Funds available: \$4,126.00, money needed is \$5,200.00 for the whole project, not including extra upkeep funds) The designation funds are enough to cover Option#1 and some money left over for mulch and other general maintenance to the Prayer Garden.) Bid, giving by Tri Ad Construction is in the Council meeting book if anyone is interested in viewing the project.

- An announcement will be placed in the Bulletin and Follower to ask for more donations toward the project.
- Mission: Betsy Hennen voiced her concern that there isn't enough communication and trust between the council and the Mission committee. Betsy will stay in contact with Cheryl Mallak (Treasurer) about available funds moving forward. She wasn't sure if the funds were being used in different ways other than missions and if so Why?
- Betsy Hennen has decided to downsize her involvement with gardening project. If anyone would like to help with the east side of the building garden, please contact the church office.
