• Reviewed budget thru Nov. 8<sup>th</sup>. We are behind in offerings by \$73,000. We did have a good second Sunday giving in November brining in around \$17,000.

- Discussed ways to promote giving. Sarah mentioned having the QR code available for the congregation.
- Plan to put an update in the bulletin where the budget is at so the congregation is aware of giving and where we need to be to meet the budget

 Cory presented information on different investment options along with retirement benefit options. See attached

 Discussed investment of Endowment, Roof and Employee Retention funds. Decision made to put both the Roof and Endowment funds into a 2 year CD for each of them and leave the Employee Retention fund as this time. Motion made by Trent Athmann and seconded by Kirk Elfering to put the Roof fund and the Endowment funds into their own 2 year CDs and leave the Employee Retention fund. Motion passed. Cheryl to talk with Cory Hebrink about doing this.

Also utilities such as heat, water and electricity have gone up over the year. Not many options to cut anything out of the budget.

1. Discussed that it would be beneficial to have a second person to be trained with helping to count offering. Currently it is Skye and Sue Erickson but it would be good to have another in the event either are gone. Notice to be put in the bulletin to see if there are any volunteers.

- Cleaning duties

    - Stacey has been in touch with Lynette Blem regarding how cleaning is going. At present time it is going well but do not feel the individuals will want to do it on a long term basis. Stacey met with Bev Wacek at the church to discuss cleaning for the church. Bev did a walk thru and discussed cleaning needs. She felt she could do it in 2 hours per week. She charges \$25 per hour. She is also willing to come if called to "spot clean" prior to weddings, funerals etc. Discussion held regarding hiring out for weekly cleaning. Motion made by Sandy Gay and second by Scott Johnson to hire Bev Wacek to clean weekly for up to 3 hours at \$25 per hour. Motion passed.
