- Approve minutes of *April meeting* Motion to approve the minutes by Bob Erickson, seconded by Elaine McDowell, motion passed.
- Treasurer Report Motion to approve the treasurer/secretary report by Sandy Gay, seconded by Scott Johnson, motion passed.
 - April shows a deficit of over \$21,700.00. Offerings in April of \$17,072.79, and considerably lower than previous months (Jan \$41,000; Feb \$20,000; March \$28,000). The biggest extra expenditures in April were the Quarterly Synod Offering of \$9,000; Synod Assembly expenses of \$1015.00 and Youth was paid their budgeted allotment of \$2500.00. The overall annual budget shows we are still ahead by \$2268.00

Motion passed with Jill Hanson and Stacey Larson abstaining from the vote.
 - Discuss debit card for the youth account
 - Motion by Jill Hanson and seconded by Stacey Larson to approve, a debit card for the Cross of Calvary Youth account at FM Bank in the name of Cross of Calvary Youth and if one card can not be put into this name approval to have two cards one in Sarah Hausken name and the other in Matt Hausken name. Motion passed.

 - Discuss lawn care hire Chad Amsden to spray/fertilize/mow
 - Lawn care individuals looking for more help to care for church, parsonage and west lawn or look to hire some help. Keith spoke with Chad Amsden and discussed spraying, fertilizing, and mowing of all the properties. Chad quoted \$150 per week for lawn care. Keith to talk with Chad about cost if he sprays, fertilizes all of the property and would just mow the west property and south outer property under pine trees. Keith to reach out to council with this quote.

 - 2015 was the last time the church directory was done. Discussed doing a new directory. At this time plan to look into it further and see if any individuals would be willing to head this up.
 - Plunketts increasing their cost
 - Plunketts increasing their cost by 4%. We are billed every two months for general pest control and rodent control. We have a yearly contract at this time of \$764.90. This does include a fall spraying around the building for pests. At this time no change to this plan as council feels this is a service that is needed.
 - Corn Capital Days
 - Received a fundraiser campaign ask from the Corn Capital Days committee for a donation. Ham Dinner to make a contribution.
 - Holy Ground grant proposal

by Jill Hanson to move forward with being the fiscal host with our 501c3 status for a Lilly Endowment Grant proposal from Pastor Kayla Monson for The Holy Ground. This was after Sister Sarah and Keith Larson looked extensively at this grant and the benefits to Cross of Calvary and discussion held via email by council members. The Holy Ground is a four phased proposal for children and family ministry within SWMN Synod. Skye Hebrink agreed to be the fiscal agent for our congregation handling all book work and payroll related to this grant if awarded. Motion passed.
