Dear Cross of Calvary Community,

Over the past few Sundays, our scripture readings have featured a central tenet of the Lutheran understanding of God and salvation.

"You did not choose me, I chose you." John 15:16
"We love because God first loved us." 1 John 4:19

"There is no fear in love . . .; for fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not reached perfection

"This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you." John 15:12

I've tried to express the crux of this key aspect of Lutheran theology during Storytime, and I want to lift it up here too The point is nuanced.



The concept I'm trying to communicate is this:

- God loved us first.
- We cannot by our own strength, goodness or decision -- earn salvation. Only God/Jesus/Holy Spirit can give that gift.
- Jesus commands us to love one another.
- If we don't recognize the first two points first, the love we share with others is not genuine.
- If we love our neighbor so that God will love us, the "love" for our neighbor is truly love for ourselves, not the other.
- The fact that God loves us first and that our salvation is assured means the love we share with our neighbor is genuine and perfect.

The motivation behind love makes or breaks the result.

This concept is why I am a Lutheran.

May the Holy Spirit work to carry this understanding to our hearts and minds. Amen!
