Dear Cross of Calvary Community,

Martin Luther, held the Word of God in the highest regard. He believed that the Bible was the ultimate authority for Christians, a beacon of divine truth that could guide believers in every aspect of their lives. Luther's insistence on sola scriptura, or "scripture alone," underscored his conviction that the Bible should be accessible to all, a source of personal faith and communal strength.

Luther famously translated the Bible into German, making it available to the common people. This monumental task was driven by his belief that everyone should engage with the Word of God directly, without trained specialists. He argued that scripture was clear and sufficient, capable of speaking to the heart of every believer. For Luther, the Bible was not just a text to be read; it was a living,

breathing testament of God's will and love.

In the spirit of Martin Luther's teachings, our many Bible studies here at Cross of Calvary aim to deepen our understanding and relationship with God's Word. These studies are more than academic exercises; they are spiritual journeys that shape our faith and strengthen our community.

Through regular Bible study sessions, we delve into the scriptures, uncovering layers of meaning and relevance for our daily lives. These gatherings are opportunities for reflection, discussion, and mutual support, allowing us to grow in faith together. Whether we are exploring the parables of Jesus, the prophetic visions of the Old Testament, or the letters of Paul, each study session is a chance to encounter the divine and be transformed by it.

Our Bible studies are structured to cater to different levels of familiarity and experience with the scriptures. Beginners are welcomed with open arms, encouraged to ask questions and share their insights. More seasoned participants find a platform to deepen their theological understanding and offer mentorship to others.


#### What is on your Heart?






#### **ELCA Youth Gathering**

  - O Phones have not been working correctly since last fall. Unable to get messages that are left and people unable to call in. Century Link has been very difficult to reach and work with. Discussed changing to Zoom. Adam Dillon is familiar with this system as it is used at the Beet Plant. You can keep your current number but it is set up thru Zoom and it is used thru the internet. Our internet is sufficient to run this program. It is a yearly fee of a little over \$200 and we can run 4 phones off of this. Discussed this option, Motion made by Kathy Reese and seconded by Elaine McDowell to discontinue service with Century Link and use Zoom as provider. Adam to work with Sarah and Laurie on setting this up.
