Parish Minister Report October 23, 24

Have I told you lately that our decision to begin regular children and youth ministry programs in October is so great?! While we don't have weekly programming in the summer, we have a series of intensive faith formation experiences: Jr. High Camp, Day Camp, Elementary Camp, Sr. High Trip, etc. If we were to begin regular programming in September, there would be no time to plan for the school year. Yet that is how most congregations operate. We run hard all summer, then run into fall already behind.

So I was grateful to have September to regroup, take time to pray and discern a plan for the school year that meets our goals of sharing the love of Christ with all ages in diverse ways, and lay the foundations of those plans. In addition, I regularly hear from parents that they love our October start. They're able to get their families into the school year routine in stages and they don't feel so overwhelmed. This has also been helpful with finding Sunday School teachers. We easily found ample teachers for every grade.

Highlights of the past month:

Sunday School

- beginning of Sunday School!
 - Skye Hebrink and Carrie Jo Gass have provided excellent leadership as Sunday School Superintendents
 - Sunday School teachers received Abuse Prevention training (free of cost, thanks to Insurance Board's relationship with Praesidium)
 - The kids decided to make buying a family farm though ELCA World Hunger the first goal for their offerings

- First Jesus Justice League for 1-2 graders
- First GLUE for 3-4 graders
- First Choir and Craft for 4-7th graders
 - Made fleece blankets for Santa's Closet using Thrivent Community Action Team grant of \$250
- They would like to learn to crochet in December, so I'm looking for adults to teach this
- WOW begins October 30
- Jr. High Game Night for 7-9th graders was a riot as usual
- First Breakfast Club for 10-12 graders we'll be meeting the 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month and trying different spiritual practices

- We have 26 6-9th graders registered for the SW MN Synod Jr. High Youth Gathering!
 - Laurence Stratton and Polly Amsden are registered as adult leaders
 - We need 2 more male adult leaders and 1 more female adult leaders

 - Unfortunately, I am unable to go to the gathering with the group. The annual Deaconess Community Assembly is that weekend this year. But I'm preparing everything and will make sure the leaders are equipped.
 - Cost for the event is \$130 per person. We are asking youth to pay \$80, and the youth account is subsiding \$50 each

Misc.

- the <u>SW MN Synod Fall Theological Conference</u> was on the Roots of the Lutheran Reformation and how it's relevant today. The speaker, Dr. Tim <u>Wengert</u> was wonderful and Pastor Matt made us sit in the front row so he could nerd out.
 - The other presenter spoke about stewardship. Things that stuck out to me:
 - Someone may be "guilted" into giving once or twice, but that's it
 - Sharing a budget deficit rarely increases giving
 - Sharing our vision and how Cross of Calvary is working towards that vision inspires giving
 - People sharing how the ministry of Cross of Calvary has affected them personally inspires giving (ex. Moments of Gratitude)
- Karen Flom and Carole Buhr have begun hosting a <u>Caregivers Support</u> group the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of the month from 2-3 pm. It has been well attended and appreciated.
- Laurie made a new system to volunteer to <u>read the lessons</u> in worship. I think it's a winner because 4 out of 5 readings have been taken already!
- We have a small group working on the new <u>Church Directory</u>: Jill Wohnoutka, Carol Senkyr, Judy Kopacek, Laurie Denning, Cheryl Mallak and myself.
 - United Church Directories will be taking directory photos Nov. 12-16.
